

Student Right-to-Know

Fall 2009 Census Data

The Student Right-to-Know Act requires that colleges and universities publish their six-year graduation rates. Concordia's current six-year graduation rate is 67%. This means that of the freshmen who enrolled at Concordia in 2003, 67% had graduated by 2009 (six years after first enrolling at Concordia). The remainder of the cohort had transferred, dropped out of college, or not yet completed their degree.



Of students who enroll in Concordia as freshmen and stay at Concordia throughout their college career, 90% complete their degree in four years.
