

# Student Right-to-Know

Fall 2011 Census Data

*The Student Right-to-Know Act requires that colleges and universities publish their six-year graduation rates. Concordia's current six-year graduation rate is 69%. This means that of the new first-year students who enrolled at Concordia in 2005, 69% had graduated by 2011 (six years after first enrolling at Concordia). The remainder of the cohort had transferred, dropped out of college, or not yet completed their degree.*



*Eighty-six percent of Concordia's 2007 new first-year students who stayed at Concordia throughout their college career completed their degrees in four years.*
